FELIX Render Contest Rules

Please read these rules (the Rules) before submitting your rendering to Felix Render UK's contest.

BASIC SUBMISSIONS GUIDELINES FOR 3D Artists

- 1. The contest Rendering has to be produced using FELIX Render as 3D rendering tool which you can download after registering at www.felixrender.com. Rendering produced with other rendering tools are rejected.
- 2. The contest is open for E-Mail submissions only, at address contest062023@felixrender.com
- 3. Submission of the final images has to happen within 01/08/2023 at 3pm GMT.
- 4. Submissions will not be accepted once the deadline lapses.
- 5. You submit one single final rendering for the contest. A screenshot of FELIX with the open scene has to be provided as a proof that the rendering has been done using FELIX. The FELIX user name has to be provided. The awarded scene has to be sent from within FELIX to user "david" ("Send scene" function in FELIX).
- 6. The Rendering submitted must be of at least 4 megapixel.
- 7. The contest has to be fulfilled by using the starting 50 credits + the daily default credits which FELIX provides. New FELIX users automatically will find those 50 credits loaded in their account. Existing users who want to participate to the contest have to contact us at contest062023@felixrender.com with with following subject: 50 contest credits for user: "user".
- 8. Basic editing, including color enhancement, the use of filters, and cropping of the rendering(s) is acceptable, provided any such editing does not affect the authenticity and/or genuineness of the rendering.
- 9. Advanced editing used to create illusions, deceptions and/or manipulations, and the adding and removing of significant elements within the frame is prohibited.
- 10. Every image uploaded is subject to a moderation process before it becomes visible on the contest page. Felix Render UK reserves the right to assess and disregard any submitted rendering at our its discretion.
- 11. Renderings that portray or otherwise include inappropriate and/or offensive content, including provocative nudity, violence, human rights and/or environmental violation, and/or any other contents deemed to be contrary to the law, religious, cultural & moral traditions and practices of India, are strictly prohibited and will be immediately discarded.
- 12. A participant who submits any such renderings may be permanently banned, subject to Felix Render UK's discretion, from participating in any future contests.

THE JUDGING

- 1. Felix Render UK will appoint 4 judges for the contest. This will comprise existing users of FELIX render and external judges.
- 2. The judging panel shall assess and determine the winning Renderings. The results and the winners will be announced on the website within the 14/07/2023.
- 3. The decision of Felix Render UK's judging panel will be final and binding on all Participants in respect to all matters relating to the Contest.
- 4. Felix Render UK reserves the right to call for original rendering files including the original scene for authentication. An rendering maybe disregarded if this information cannot be provided.

THE PRIZES

- 1. The first prize of 2000 Euro and the second prize of 600 Euro will be paid via Paypal or via wire transfer within the 31/07/2023 if the winners submitted the necessary transaction details within 24/07/2023. The 1000 credits will be assigned to the winner of the third prize within the 24/07/2023.
- 2. Any state/ provincial/ territorial, and/or local taxes, fees and surcharges and taxes (whether foreign or domestic, and including income tax) on any prize that may be awarded to You under the Contest will be solely paid by You.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- 1. Submitted renderings must be original, created by the contestant. It must not contain any materials owned or controlled by a third party for which you have not obtained a license, must not infringe the copyright, trademark, moral rights, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights of any person or entity.
- 2. Felix Render UK respects 3D artist's copyrights and copyrights shall remain vested with the creator of the rendering. Upon making the submission, you grant Felix Render UK, worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty free, sub-licensable right and license to use, publish, reproduce, display, perform, adapt, create derivative works, distribute, have distributed, print, in whole or in part, in any form, in all media forms now or hereafter known, to promote the contest, rendering, the 3D artist or for editorial or educative use.
- 3. The 3D artist will be credited wherever the image is used.

LIABILITY

1. You hereby hold harmless, release, indemnify and discharge Felix Render UK and its partners, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising

agencies, agents and their employees, officers and representatives from all liability, claims, judgments, demands, controversies, agreements, damages, actions and causes of action whatsoever, arising out of or related in any way to the contest or the conduct of the contest and the acceptance and use, misuse, or possession of any prize awarded, whether in law or in equity, no matter what the cause or nature, and You further waive any claims that You may state or assert against Felix Render UK in association with the contest or any of its associated activities, or in any way related to or resulting from the contest even if such injury or claims results from or is caused by the negligence or gross negligence of Felix Render UK, in whole or in part, due to human error or otherwise.
